### Polaris IQ Trak Ski Runner (2006-11) Runner Information

To replace stock runners, check for the number of bolts currently being used on your stock ski. If your stock ski comes with 3 or 4 bolts use the Woody's 1225 runner series, which has 3 bolts. This runner series will also fit the 4 bolt pattern.

If your stock ski comes with 6 bolts use two pair of Woody's 7125 runner series.

This Polaris stock ski needs Woody's 7125 runner series because of the 6 bolts.
